Please note the following information related to the development webinars for diving judges:

Course description

- The FINA Diving Development School Webinar for Judges is equivalent to a FINA Diving Development School for Judges.
- It takes place through the [FINA Learning Platform](#), using the [Zoom](#) video conference tool.
- It is only accessible to those candidates approved through the FINA GMS.
- The webinar has a duration of two (2) days and includes an online test.
- The official working language for FINA Diving Development School Webinars is English.

Eligibility

- The FINA Diving Development School Webinar for Judges is designed for those participants with limited basic knowledge or no experience in judging.
- It is open to all the National Federations that have requested judges' instruction and do not have any judges training in place.
- Participants must be at least 16 years old at the start of the FINA Diving Development School Webinar.

Registration

- Each FINA Diving Development School Webinar requires a minimum of ten (10) and may have a maximum of thirty (30) participants.

Webinar access

- The login details and the webinar's instructions will be sent to the candidate's email address as submitted in the registration.

Assessment

- A judge must score a minimum of 85% in order to pass the FINA Diving Development School Webinar.
- Once a participant has passed the test, he/she will be able to download a certificate. This certificate is equivalent to the one obtained after passing a FINA Diving Development School.
