## ENTRY PROCESS

All entries shall be made electronically via the FINA General Management System (GMS) via the link <https://data.fina.org>. Access to the registration system should be via the logins previously supplied to your Federation. ### For National Federations participating in duet and team event:

In addition to the ten (10) sport entries per team (9 athletes and 1 reserve), please note that due to the exceptional circumstances created by the COVID-19 pandemic, for this qualification tournament only, National Federations are allowed to keep a substitute athlete registered after the deadline (without any sport entries) and to bring this athlete on site to be able to replace another athlete in case of Covid-19 positive tests. Accordingly, there can be a maximum of 11 athletes in the delegation (9 athletes and 2 reserves).

### For National Federations participating in duet only:

The same principle applies for duets (2 athletes and 1 reserve). National Federations are allowed to keep a substitute athlete registered after the deadline (without any sport entries) and to bring this athlete on site to be able to replace another athlete in case of Covid-19 positive tests. Accordingly, there can be a maximum of 4 athletes in the delegation (2 athletes and 2 reserves).

In duet the reserves may only be entered in case of injury and/or COVID-19 infection. The same 2 athletes must be entered for the Free and Technical routines.

The athletes must be duly registered by the registration deadline of **28th January 2021** and the sport entries must be made accordingly by the sport entries deadline of **18th February 2021**.

## VISA

All visitors to Tokyo, Japan should have a valid visa for their entry and stay in the country. Japan Swimming Federation (JASF) will facilitate an entry visa to Tokyo, Japan for all participants of the Artistic Swimming Olympic Games Qualification Tournament who have completed their registration in the FINA GMS by the registration deadline. Please make sure that the visa fields are completed correctly in the GMS with the city and country where you will apply for the visa.

## COVID-19

The Government of Japan and Tokyo 2020 decided the special arrangement to ease the immigration restrictions for persons directly involved in the delivery of the Tokyo 2020 Games who are vital to the preparations and Athletes who will participate in Tokyo 2020 Test Events.

Likewise, special arrangement to ease the immigration restrictions for ARTISTIC SWIMMING OLYMPIC GAMES QUALIFICATION TOURNAMENT 2021 for persons directly involved in the delivery of this tournament who are vital to the preparations and Athletes who will participate in this tournament.

### <Outline of the Special Arrangement>

#### 1. Persons eligible to apply for this Special Arrangement.

- (1) Persons crucial for the preparations of the tournament (IF etc.)
- (2) Athletes participating in the tournament.
- (3) Those accompanying persons who are essential for conditioning of the athletes

#### 2. Required Epidemic Prevention Measures

##### (1) Before Departing Your Country

- Proof of a negative PRR test for COVID-19 (up to 72 hours before departure)
- Take temperature for 14 days before departure for Japan.

##### (2) 14 days after entering Japan.

- Using apps to report health condition, use of contact confirmation apps, keeping location data for 14 days.
- Action range will be restricted to the round trip between the business destination and accommodation.
- In principle, prohibition of using public transportation etc.
